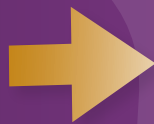


Our journey in 2024

Cancer Immunotherapy



The U.S. Patent and Trademark Office granted a patent for the invention “Immunogenic composition for the treatment of cancer and methods of preparing the same” to protect ConvitVax.



Published “Structuring a BALB/c mice colony in the Unidad Experimental de Inmunoterapia of Fundación Jacinto Convit – Venezuela” in Revista Veterinaria, establishing our own strain of mice for preclinical studies with ConvitVax.



Published “Breast Cancer Immunotherapy: Realities and Advances” in Cancer Innovation, a review of breast cancer immunotherapies to date, including ConvitVax.

Molecular Diagnostics



Performed 1,715 tests this year, benefiting 343 highly vulnerable patients and 1,372 relatives, bringing the total number of patients impacted to 1,868 as of date.



Signed 3 new agreements with reference public hospitals in Venezuela, reaching a total of 13 health institutions impacted by this program.



Expanded the reach of the program to 3 new states in Venezuela, covering a total of 8 out of 23 states to date.

Benefited 11 students during the year, bringing the total to 55 beneficiaries throughout the program.



Enrolled students from the United States and Lebanon, reaching a total of 18 countries to date from 25 different majors.



Completed 20 presentations on scientific topics of interest and published 4 outreach articles in the press room of our website.

JCWO participated in the worldwide generosity movement promoted by Global Giving, which encourages people to give back to their communities and charities.

The goal was to raise funds to provide molecular-based tests for leukemia to the most vulnerable pediatric patients being treated in public hospitals across Venezuela. These patients lack access to specialized exams needed to direct their treatment.

Thanks to 37 donors, we were able to raise a total of US\$14,963.
